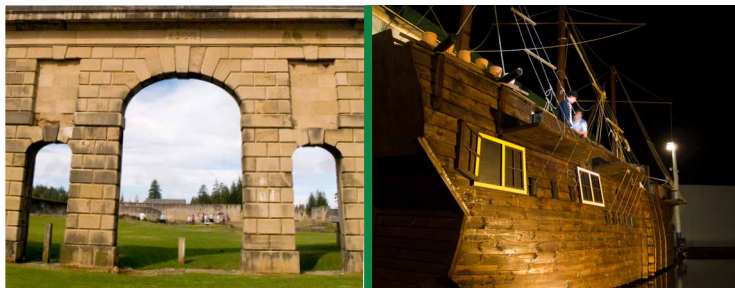

Day 1 – Thursday 3 April 2014 (D) Melbourne - Sydney

Melbourne passengers depart for Sydney. On arrival transfer by shuttle to Airport Sydney International Inn where accommodation has been confirmed for you for one night.

Day 2 – Friday 4 April 2014 (L in Flight, D) Sydney – Norfolk Island / Night as a Convict

Sydney passengers will meet the rest of the group at the airport this morning for the flight to Norfolk. On arrival on Norfolk you will be met by our local ground operator – Pinetree Tours and transferred to the South Pacific Resort Hotel. Enjoy a welcome Tropical Fruit Punch on arrival before checking into your rooms. Accommodation has been confirmed for 7 nights in a Garden Room. Tonight is a fun night out for all ages. Dress as a convict and join with the Commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing and dancing (Outfits supplied).

Day 3 – Saturday 5 April 2014 (B, D) Half Day Orientation Tour / RSL Dinner

This morning you'll be collected by Pinetree Tours for a Half Day Orientation tour of the island. On this private group tour this afternoon you'll visit historic Kingston, Cascade, Longridge and much more. Lunch is own arrangements and afternoon is at leisure. Tonight you will enjoy a 2 course dinner at the Norfolk Island RSL. Afterwards Rodney will have the joint jumping as he takes to the stage.

Day 4 – Sunday 6 April 2014 (B, D) Convict Settlement / Fletcher's Fate

This morning you will go on an in depth tour of the historic Georgian settlement of Kingston. Walk through the cemetery and hear the history of interesting convict and colonial headstones and hear stories of the houses along Quality Row. Lunch is own arrangements and afternoon is at leisure. Tonight is a fascinating evening of interactive theatre, intrigue and mystery. This entertaining play, examining the possible last movements and final whereabouts of the famous mutineer, Fletcher Christian, is dramatically acted out by a 6 character cast over a sumptuous 3 course dinner.

Day 5 – Monday 7 April 2014 (B, D) Cyclorama / La Perouse / Sound and Light

This morning visit Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama, an unforgettable experience. Walk inside the continuous 360 degree panoramic painting that traces the history of the Bounty leaving England through Tahiti, Pitcairn Island and arrival at Norfolk Island in 1856. Lunch is own arrangements and the afternoon is at leisure. Tonight enjoy a dinner at La Perouse Restaurant at the Paradise Hotel and Resort. After dinner is the Sound and Light Show. Nightfall at Kingston brings a different mood to the Convict Settlement. With the dramatic use of real life sounds, theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as Pinetree Tours takes you through the horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era.

Day 6 – Tuesday 8 April 2014 (B, D) Behind the Hedges / Island Fish Fry / Mutiny on the Bounty

This morning travel to Anson Bay to visit a small hobby farm, which has been instrumental in improving the local livestock industry. Close by see a demonstration at Norfolk's major pottery and browse at the Cottage Pottery shop. After a delicious morning tea at a scenic location, visit a beautiful private and commercial garden that supplies the local florists with stock. Finish the morning with a visit to a large banyan tree on a private property. Lunch is own arrangements and the afternoon is a leisure. This evening you will enjoy a feast of Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by Island desserts. Enjoy some local entertainment on Norfolk's beautiful Puppy's Point. Tonight see descendants of the mutineers bring the story of the famed 'Mutiny on the Bounty' and historic events to life in an outdoor amphitheatre on Norfolk's western coastline.

Day 7 – Wednesday 9 April 2014 (B, D) Breakfast Bush Walk / Progressive Dinner

This morning take your choice of a stroll through One Hundred Acres Reserve or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument. At the end of the walk everyone will meet up on the cliff top for a delicious breakfast barbecue. Lunch is own arrangements and the afternoon is a leisure. Tonight enjoy a 3 course meal progressing to different Norfolk Island family homes.

Day 8 – Thursday 10 April 2014 (B, D) Glass Bottom Boat / Dinner at Hotel / Farewell Concert

Today view beautiful coral gardens and tropical fish inside the calm crystal waters of Norfolk's lagoon on a glass bottom boat tour. Tonight is a 3 course Farewell Dinner at your hotel. After dinner Rodney will take stage for an evening of fun and laughter. Some singing, some dancing, some jokes. A great night promised and a fantastic way to end your week on Norfolk.

Day 9 – Friday 11 April 2014 (B, L in Flight) Norfolk – Sydney - Melbourne
