#### Day 1 – Thursday 10 August 2017 (D)

Depart Melbourne 3:00PM – Arrive Sydney 4:00PM (D)

On arrival in Sydney transfer by shuttle to your Sydney Airport Hotel. Relax and enjoy dinner at your hotel

#### Day 2 – Friday 11 August 2017 (B, D) Depart Sydney 9:40AM – Arrive Norfolk 1:15PM/Night as a Convict

Early breakfast at the hotel this morning. The hotel shuttle will transfer you to the airport in time for your flight to Norfolk Island. Passengers departing ex Sydney will meet the group at Sydney Airport this morning. On arrival you need to collect your checked luggage and clear customs and immigration. Once in the main terminal you will be met by our local ground operator – Pinetree Tours and transferred to the Castaway, which will be your home for the next 7 nights. This boutique hotel has been fully refurbished and is ideally located in a lovely quiet spot just a short walk to the centre of town or a few minutes' drive to the historic Kingston precinct. Developed from an historic family home, Castaway continues to be family owned and operated with exceptional friendly island hospitality. Enjoy a welcome Tropical fruit cocktail on arrival before checking into your rooms. Tonight is a fun night out for all ages. Dress as a convict and join in with the Commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing and dancing. Great food and great fun. (Outfits supplied).

#### Day 3 – Saturday 12 August 2017 (B, D) Half Day Orientation Tour/Dinner at La Perouse/Wonderland By Night

The morning is at leisure and lunch is own arrangements. Pinetree Tours Half Day Orientation Tour is a must for every visitor. Visit historic Kingston, Cascade, Longridge and much more. See and hear about the famous convict buildings, beautiful beaches and golf course, the renowned Melanesian Chapel, local Government laws and lifestyle. Enjoy views from scenic spots on this full commentary conducted tour. Afternoon tea is included. Dinner tonight is a 2 course dinner at one of Norfolk's great local restaurants before heading to Wonderland by Night. The setting is 10 acres of magical Norfolk pines and bushland lit up like an enchanted forest. #### Day 4 – Sunday 13 August 2017 (B, D) Convict Settlement Tour/Fletcher's Fate

The morning is at leisure and lunch today is own arrangements. This afternoon join Pinetree Tours on an in-depth tour of the historic Georgian Settlement of Kingston. Walk through the cemetery and hear the history of interesting convict and colonial headstones and hear stories of the houses along Quality Row. Walk through the ruins of the new gaol; see the Pier Store, boat shed and the crank mill. Afternoon tea is included.

#### Day 5 – Monday 14 August 2017 (B, D) Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama/'A Little Bit Country'

Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama is an unforgettable experience. This is one of only a handful of paintings of this type in the world and is based on an art form made popular in the 1800's. Walk inside the circular painting and be surrounded by the immense artwork. A spectacular 3D effect is achieved in this painting with its detailed artwork and realistic perspective and the story that traces the history of the Bounty leaving England through Tahiti, Pitcairn Island and arrival at Norfolk Island in 1856. The rest of the morning is at leisure and lunch today is own arrangements. Tonight, after dinner at one of Norfolk's hotels, your host performs alongside of Graeme Hugo, Joy Adams and Fortunato Isgro. Graeme is one of South Australia's most hardworking independent artists. He has a great rapport with audiences of all ages and is a real crowd pleaser. Joy is one of NZ's best known country entertainers. She has an extensive repertoire plus a natural flair for comedy. And more than a little bit country we have a little bit of wonderful variety from Fortunato Isgro, who is an entertainer from Brisbane renowned for his strong vocals, extensive repertoire and great versatility. A fabulous night's entertainment is assured.

#### Day 6 – Tuesday 15 August 2017 (B, D) Norfolk Indulgence Tour/Island Fish Fry/Sound and Light Show

The morning is at leisure and lunch is own arrangements. A relaxing afternoon - this tour will visit our local chocolate shop for a demonstration and tasting of the local chocolate. This will be followed by a stop at the Liquors Factory. Afterwards enjoy a delicious afternoon tea in a scenic location. Late this afternoon enjoy a feast of Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by Island desserts and tea or coffee. Watch the sun set from Puppies' Point on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline and enjoy some local entertainment. Later this evening is the Sound and Light Show. Nightfall at Kingston brings a different mood to the Convict Settlement. The stillness and the stars are there just as they were before settlers arrived in 1788. With the dramatic use of real life sounds, theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as Pinetree Tours takes you through the horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era.

#### Day 7 – Wednesday 16 August 2017 (B, D) Breakfast Bush Walk/Progressive Dinner

This morning take your choice of a stroll through One Hundred Acres Reserve or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument. If you prefer not to rise early and bush walk you'll be picked up a little later and taken to join the walkers at Anson Bay as they return from their walk and where you'll all enjoy a delicious breakfast barbecue on the clifftop. The rest of the day is at leisure and lunch is own arrangements. Tonight enjoy a 3 course meal progressing to different Norfolk Island family homes. A fun night and a great way to meet the local people and sample some of the Island dishes.

#### Day 8 – Thursday 17 August 2017 (B, D) Tin-a-aii Tour/'A Little Bit Country – A Bit of a Shindig'

Tin-a-Aii in the Norfolk language means to look at beautiful things. On this tour Pinetree Tours will take you to some of the island's scenic spots and you'll want to have your camera ready. From the panoramic views from Mt Pitt to Captain Cook Memorial - the landing place of Captain Cook and now part of the National Park. Beautiful sea views, towering pines and a stop for morning tea in a scenic location. Lunch today is own arrangements and the afternoon is at leisure. Tonight enjoy a second show from your hosts for the week – Rodney, Graeme, Joy and Fortunato. You'll be collected by Pinetree Tours and taken to a fabulous scenic location.
